Michigan Cavalry, Gen. Kilpatrick learning of his ability and desperate courage detailed him as a scout. While on this duty he was captured within the rebel line, near Richards Ferry, Va., wearing a Confederate uniform and was tried, convicted and sentenced to be hanged as a spy, on the 27th day of April, 1864. On that day the death warrant was read to him in his cell and he was carried to the place of execution, but by the timely interference of Gen. Kilpatrick his life was saved. He was sent to Libby Prison and from thence to Pemberton Prison, from which place he finally succeeded in making his escape after suffering all the miseries and horrors of a rebel hell. "Five of these soldiers are now dead and the secret so far has been religiously kept.

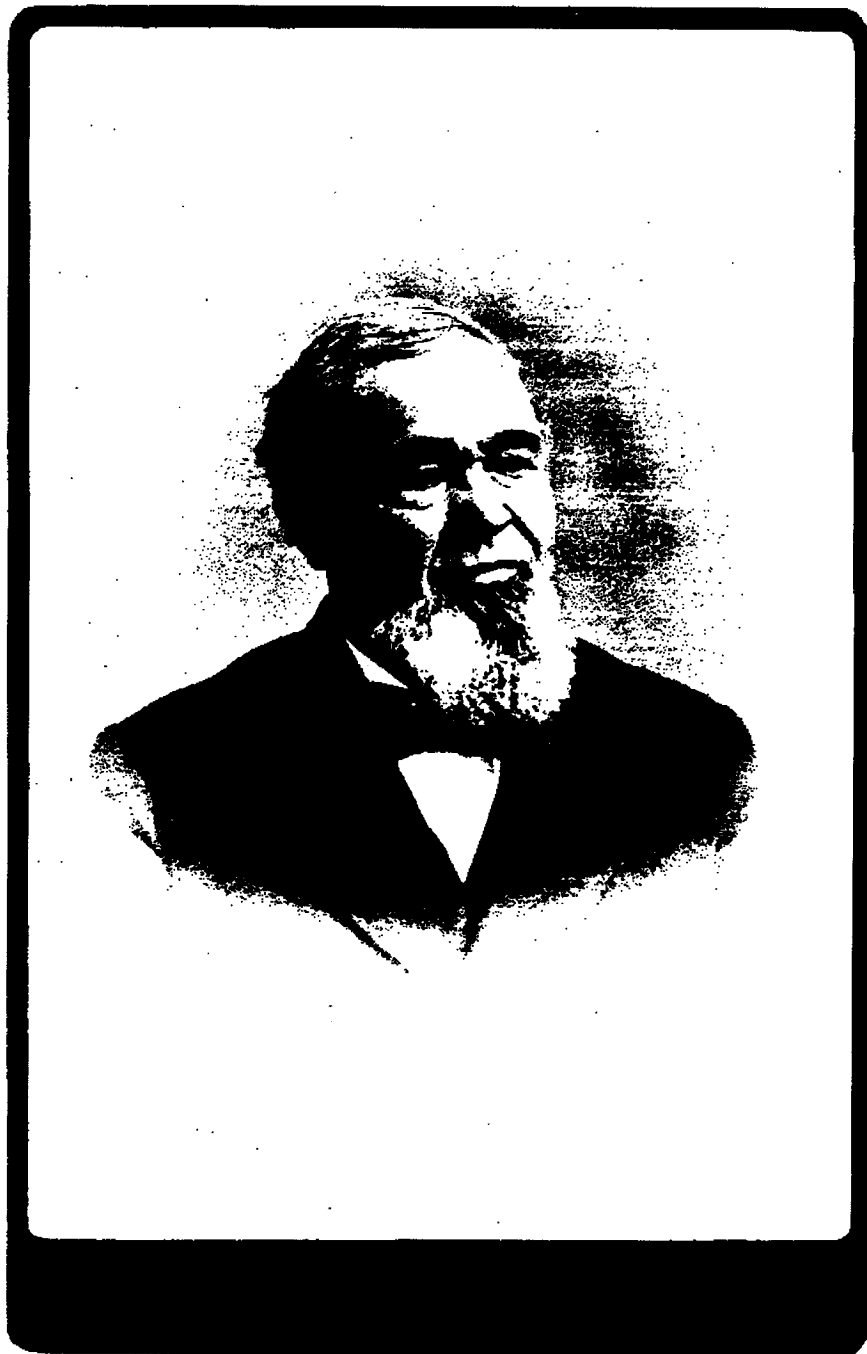
